Many doctors include pre-operative and post-operative care in their overall prices, as well as one-year to lifetime warranties. It's important to know what is included in each package, so you can make fair comparisons.

Due to the prohibitive cost of laser eye surgery, many patients opt to deal with the LASIK eye centers that offer affordable or easy payment plans. If price is an issue, speak with your LASIK eye center surgeon about possible financing to cover the costs involved. Many LASIK eye center surgeons offer a variety of financing options to their patients. Some centers will even work with local and national banks to provide low interest monthly financing plans. Or, they simply allow patients to pay for the procedure in installments.
