Chemical concentrates are used in conjunction with others, or in varying strength, depending on what strength is necessary. The strength of the peel also depends on where it is placed on the face. Some areas will have a greater number of skin layers than others. Additionally, a person may decide to have a chemical peel as well as a face-lift when they are evaluating available cosmetic procedures.

If you make the decision to get a chemical peel, you will need to allow three to seven days for recovery due to the strength of the chemicals. It is also necessary to stay out of direct sunlight for three months while the skin cells are recovering. You should also expect to have anesthesia administered during the procedure and you may need to remain in the vicinity for a few hours after the surgery to be sure you have suffered no side affects.
